Purpose of Meeting

Warden Habinski stated the original purpose of the meeting was to discuss a request from David Wang, Quzhou, China. Since calling the special session, three additional items have surfaced which require Council's attention.

<u>Re:</u> Request from David Wang, Quzhou, China – an invitation has been extended for the Municipality to send representatives to Quzhou, China, to attend meetings of a tourism nature. This trip would begin on or about April 1st, 2017 and will take approximately 7 days.

Councillors expressed their happiness at receiving the invitation, noting this was a significant step which speaks well to the performance of the delegation sent before.

Councillor Morrison moved, seconded by Councillor LeBlanc, in response to the invitation of David Wang, that Warden Habinski and a staff member chosen by the CAO, constitute the Annapolis County delegation to return to China to continue discussions and the promising results. Motion carried unanimously.

Deputy Warden Roberts inquired as to how the costs associated with the trip would be paid. Costs will be taken into consideration during the budget build for 2017-18 for the CAO'S strategic initiatives line item.

Councillor Morrison requested permission to be excused from the meeting at 10:34 a.m. Permission was granted.

Challenges in flying economy class on such a long flight were discussed. It was the consensus of Council that the Warden and staff member be allowed to fly more comfortably – greater than economy class - and that a deal on costs be obtained if possible.
