Re: Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal (TIR) Joint Projects Funding

MOTION 190418.01 TIR Bay Road Upgrade Project – Approve Funding \$436,500 plus HST It was moved by Councillor Fowler, seconded by Councillor Heming, to authorize an expenditure of \$436,500 plus HST for the TIR Bay Road Upgrade Project, with \$255,916.67 from Gas Tax, \$5,916.67 from Bridgetown Water Reserve, and \$94,667.67 from Bridgetown Sewer Reserve. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION 190418.02 TIR Highway 8 Upgrade Project – Approve Funding \$160,000 Councillor Gunn moved, seconded by Councillor Heming, to authorize an expenditure of \$160,000 for the TIR Highway 8 Upgrade Project, funding to come from Gas Tax. Motion carried unanimously.
