Disposing food waste

- Re-freeze food before handling. This will cut down on the odor.
- After the food is frozen, remove waste from packaging and put into the compost bin. Plastic and Styrofoam food packaging should not be placed in the compost bin; they need to be disposed of separately.
- If the compost bin is full, additional food waste should be put into a clear plastic bag.
- If the food item is unable to be removed from its packaging, the packaging and food waste should be placed in a clear plastic bag. If the bag is heavy, it should be double bagged.
- Fluids (such as milk, juice, soda) should be drained before disposal. Empty containers should be recycled, disposed of as appropriate.
- In order to avoid wild animals, put the trash out in the morning, prior to 7:00 am. There will be leniency on waste bag limits for impacted residents.
- This special pickup will not be picking up appliances or bulky waste. Additional plans are being put into place to assist with the disposal of bulky items moving forward.
- **DO NOT** tape up the fridge / freezer with food inside and put it on the curb. It is illegal to dispose of appliances in this manner.
- **DO NOT** use black bags to dispose of food waste.
